## Office update.

A Happy New year to you all. I hope it is off to a good start for you.



We finished last year with 285 students with some of them doing more than one course in the year, (343 if you count those)  
All but one target for provision (there were 12 different streams) was met and that was Targeted Workplace, because the hours of provision were not met. This fund has disappeared in 2015, and been replaced by Workplace funding which has different criteria for participation.  
Averil has been working hard with Literacy Aotearoa to achieve alternative funding for some of last years workplace students. This takes time which means some have not started this year. Step Up to Step Out will begin on March 2nd along with Computing For Your Future.  
All of the Initial assessment forms that we use have been updated by Literacy Aotearoa to meet new reporting requirements by the T.E.C and the range of services we offer.  
We are being encouraged to use 'Pathways Awarua', an online learning programme for our students that is linked to the learning progressions. There will be a presentation on this at the area hui.  
Its that time of year again. The A.G.M. is on April 13th. More info to follow at a later date. As you will see planning is underway for a Southern Area Hui on March 28th. Averil and look forward to working with you this year.
